ORDER

1. The following excerpts from Article 01132, Ship's Organization and Regulations, are quoted below for compliance, and will be enforced as of this date:

*F. DUNGAREES

(b) The only men permitted to wear dungarees at mess for the evening meal are the personnel concerned with flight operations or the engineer force going on watch immediately thereafter or coming off watch except when the latter may have soiled clothing.

(c) All personnel not on watch shall shift into the Uniform of the Day at the end of normal working hours."
